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Which students to target

- Students who may leave school at the end of the year without Level 2
- Students who have the potential to achieve Level 2

Qualitative & Quantitative Data

- NCEA achievement to date
- Credits still available within courses
- Barriers to achievement for the individual student

Selling ART

- Shared lunch invitation to students
- Venue, menu and attendees
- Explain the reason for inclusion in the programme
- Students nominate their in school and out of school mentors
- Holes in the net

Getting Staff on board

- List shared with all staff
- Target student approach school wide
- ART student staff meeting to share knowledge included PI Support worker, Deans and SMT.

Needs of Students

- Attendance – being present for the learning
- Self Efficacy
- Support – tutoring, goal setting, mentor interaction

Term 4 Week 2 . . .

- 21 students initially identified
- 2 have achieved NCEA Level 2 since ART commenced
- 3 have left school
- 1 intends to return to school in 2014
- 16 remain on the list
 - 40% are entered into few external standards
 - 40% have the potential to achieve further credits within existing programmes *if they attend classes!*

Mentor Training

- Relationship based
- Guide on the side *vs* rescuer
- Goals and action plans
